4. School Director's Report (Lisa Clark)

- a. Enrollment as of September 20, 2017: 130 Kindergarten students and 36 1st grade students are fully enrolled. 5 additional Kindergartners have verbally accepted seating and await orientation. One 1st grade student has fully registered and has a pending start date of September 21, 2017. 64 Kindergarteners and 22 1st graders are currently wait-listed.
- b. Discussion around providing professional development in TCI training to all faculty and staff members to help address some of the more serious behavior issues. A subcommittee of board members will be created to explore the best practices to help address the social and emotional needs of students enrolled at the school. Sub-committee to possibly be chaired by Michelle Swanger-Gagne.
- b. As of the September 21st board meeting, all staff positions have been filled with the exception of one Kindergarten teacher, one Apprentice Teacher, a Dean of Students, and a Receptionist.
 - i. Currently, interviews are being conducted to fill all remaining positions.
 - ii. One Kindergarten teacher resigned and the position was filled with new diversity hire
 - iii. A Special Education Teacher has resigned.
 - iv. Ms. Patrice James was promoted to Parent Liaison, a full-time position.
 - v. Two part-time lunch room assistants were recently hired.
- c. Phones are up and intercom system is being worked on. A full-size copier has been acquired.
- d. A request has been made to hire a part-time TA-certified IT technician to help with instructional support and help trouble shoot technology issues.
- e. The School Leader has requested help from the Board of Trustees to design a strategic plan for the school.

5. Finance Report and Updates (Lisa Clark/Jennifer Bulling)

- a. A new kindergarten classroom will be added, bringing the total of Kindergarten classrooms up to six. This will also reduce the current Kindergarten classroom size from 30 students per class down to 24 students per class.
- b. Teacher Retirement System payments have not started to accrued yet.
- c. The School currently has a positive cash flow:
 - i. Title I funding came in and was \$23,000.00 higher than budgeted.
 - ii. A Title IA grant of \$15,000.00 was awarded to the school.
- d. As expected, the School's expenses are running high due to the school's opening and are estimated to level off in the month of October. Much of this expense is attributed to the large amount of materials ordered for the school's opening/classroom setup, and to the cost of busing for the two weeks of transportation necessary prior to the start of school for the Rochester City School District's official start date

e. The invoice for November and December billing will be submitted the first week of October.
